He was a direct student of Seikichi Toguchi Sensei, who was a student of Chojun Miyagi Sensei and Seko Higa Sensei. Kuba Sensei epitomizes the understanding of Goju-Ryu and his understand of its concepts and application is legendary but off and on the dojo floor. He run a full-time acupuncturist practice in Okinawa and is head of the Acupuncture Association in Japan.
